How to find your ring size

Please follow carefully the instructions below to make sure you order a ring to your size.

Step 1: Check the paper size using the printed scale

- a. Before printing this page, make sure that the option 'scalling' in the dialog window of the printer indicates 'none'.
- b. Use a ruler to make sure the measurements printed on the right are accurate (5 cm width by 5 cm in height).
- c. If the measurements are not accurate, make sure again that you print this page to scale, and then start again.

Step 2: Find the circle that matches your size

- a. Choose one of your rings that you wear easily or, if it's a gift, choose a ring belonging to the recipient of the gift. A simple ring is ideal for providing an accurate measurement.
- b. Make sure you take the right measurement in the right hand. Your ring size will be around a half-size larger on the hand you use to write.
- c. Place the ring on the graph below and find the circle with the outside edge at the inner circumference of your ring. The circle you have to choose is the one that coincides exactly with the inner rim of the ring.
- d. If the ring size is between two circles, order the size above.

Step 3: Order

Use the drop-down menu on the item description page to choose your ring size.
